Day 1 Wed., June 1

DEPARTURE

Departure from Newark International Airport late this morning. Meals and in-flight services are per airline policies.

NOTE: It is possible that the itinerary may be adjusted per discretion of the guide and tour leader.

Day 2 Thu., June 2

ARRIVE TEL AVIV

Region: Mediterranean Sea Coastline



Upon morning arrival at **Tel Aviv**, proceed through passport control to claim baggage and meet our guide. Board private coach and drive along the Mediterranean Sea Coastline to **Kibbutz Nachsholim**, where we will enjoy the beach and reside overnight. Have easy access to your beach attire if you wish to swim.

Day 3 Fri., June 3

CAESAREA TO SEA OF GALILEE

Region: Caesarea, Mt. Carmel, Sharon Plain, Lower Galilee



Visit the magnificent ruins of **Caesarea Maritima**, including Pilate's palace (Acts 23-26), the Herodian harbor and the hippodrome for

chariot races. Then we drive up **Mt. Carmel** to **Muhraka**, the traditional site for the confrontation of Elijah and the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18). After lunch, we cross the country to the **Arbel Cliff** for a panoramic view over the **Sea of Galilee**, the area of Jesus' mission. Lodging at Ma'agan Holiday Village along the Sea of Galilee.

Day 4 Sat., June 4

SEA CIRCLE TRIP

Region: Sea of Galilee

Begin the day with a baptismal service at the **Jordan River**. Tracing the sites of Jesus' earthly ministry, visit the **Mt. of Beatitudes** (Matthew 5-7). (*Modest dress required—knees*



and shoulders covered—here and at all church/synagogue sites.) We explore the nearby synagogue and village at **Capernaum**, the headquarters for Jesus' public mission. Enjoy St. Peter's fish (other food options available) at a restaurant near the lake. Visit **Magdala**, hometown of Mary Magdalene, viewing remains of the 1st century AD synagogue in which Jesus would have preached (Mark 1:39). After seeing an ancient fishing boat from Jesus' time, we **sail on the Sea of Galilee** in a wooden boat modeled after one from Jesus' time.

Day 5 Sun., June 5

UPPER JORDAN

Region: Upper Galilee and Golan Heights: Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi (Banias)



We travel north for a visit at **Hazor**, Canaan's largest city. We continue north and east to hike the nature reserve at **Dan** and see the rushing headwaters of the **Jordan**. Here we visit the **high place** built at Dan by Jeroboam, son of Nebat (1 Kings 12). After lunch, proceed to **Banias** (Caesarea Philippi) at the foot of **Mount Hermon**, recalling Peter's Confession (Matthew 16). We return to our lodging for dinner and **evening candlelight**

service on shore of the **Sea of Galilee**.

Day 6 Mon., June 6 JEZREEL PLAIN, LOWER GALILEE

Ramadan

Region: Megiddo, Sepphoris, Nazareth



We journey to **Megiddo** to explore its impressive underground water system and the background of the prophecy concerning **Armageddon** (the hill ["Ar"] of **Megiddo**). Following lunch, we cross the lower **Galilee**, and drive to **Sepphoris** (Herod Antipas' capital city during the life of Jesus), then to **Nazareth**, the boyhood home of Jesus. Visit a church built over the ancient village's spring (**Mary's Well**). We drive to the Nazareth ridge overlooking the site of the ancient village on one side and the **Jezreel Plain** with **Mt. Tabor** on the other, then return to lodging.

Day 7 Tue., June 7

JORDAN VALLEY

Region: Beth Shean, Jericho, Wadi Qilt

Explore the extensive remains of the capital of the Roman Decapolis at **Beth Shean**. Here we will recall the Biblical story of the death of Saul and Jonathan (1 Samuel 31). Continue to **Jericho**, the world's lowest and oldest city, for lunch and a view of its ancient tower and walls. Wending



our way “up to Jerusalem,” we branch off to **Wadi Qilt** and the **ancient Jerusalem-Jericho road**, the setting for the *Parable of the Good Samaritan*. Ascend to **Mt. Scopus** for a special welcome to **Jerusalem**. Accommodations while in Jerusalem are at the Ambassador Hotel.

Day 8 Wed., June 8

JERUSALEM

Region: Mount of Olives, Gethsemane, Bethlehem, Archaeological Tunnel Along Temple Wall

After an orientation to the city from the **Mount of Olives**, we descend by foot down the traditional Palm Sunday road, stopping at the **Church of Dominus Flevit** (the Lord weeps). We descend further to **Gethsemane**, visiting the **Church of All Nations** and meditating in its semi-private garden. Enjoy lunch at nearby **Bethlehem**, birthplace of David and Jesus.

Walking through **Manger Square**, visit the **Church of the Nativity**, and recount the story of Ruth and Boaz (Book of Ruth). Shopping is available for olive wood carvings, jewelry, and souvenirs. Return



to our Jerusalem hotel. After dinner we visit the **Western Wall Archaeological Tunnel**, showing the outer Temple wall with its Herodian stones in pristine condition. Return to the Ambassador Hotel for overnight.

Day 9 Thu., June 9

JERUSALEM

Region: Temple Mount, Via Dolorosa, Yad Vashem

Getting an early start, we ascend the **Temple Mount** (Haram e-Sharif/Mount Moriah) with the **Dome of the Rock** and the **al-Aqsa Mosque**. (Because of Ramadan, women must be dressed with long sleeves and all must be dressed from top to toe.)

We then visit **St. Anne's Church**, briefly pausing there to enjoy a time in song. View the nearby remains of the **Pools of Bethesda** (John 5). We follow the traditional **Via Dolorosa**, ending at the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher** (view those aspects of the church that require a guide as a group, leaving the rest for individual free time). After lunch, visit **Yad Vashem** (the Holocaust Museum). Return to the Ambassador Hotel for overnight.

Day 10 Fri., June 10

RIFT VALLEY

Region: Dead Sea, Masada, Ein Gedi, Qumran



Travel along the shore of the Dead Sea to **Masada**, ascending to the top of the fortress by cable car. Witness the Herodian grandeur and hear the story of the Jewish revolt

against Rome (66–70 AD). We then backtrack to the beautiful oasis at **Ein Gedi**, observing wildlife such as ibex and conies while hiking up to its waterfalls. On to **Qumran**, home of the **Essenes**, where we will visit remains of their community and view a cave where most of the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were found. We pause for an afternoon float in the sea. Return to the Ambassador in Jerusalem for overnight. (At dinner, our Prayer Partners will be revealed.)



Day 11 Sat., June 11

SHEPHELAH OF JUDAH

Region: Lowlands

Visit Biblical sites in the **Shephelah** (Lowlands between the Judean highlands and the coast) including the **Valley of Elah** (David vs. Goliath) and **Tel Lachish**. Additional possibilities: **Beth Shemesh** with a view of the **Sorek Valley** (Samson country); **Maresha, Qeiyafa** (a newly discovered city from the time of David, overlooking the Valley of Elah); **Gath**, which was by far the largest Philistine city in the late 10th–9th centuries BC; and **Gezer**. Return to the Ambassador for overnight.

Day 12 Sun., June 12

JERUSALEM

Free Morning / Israel Museum and Dead Sea Scrolls

Morning: Worship at a place of your choosing (Jerusalem Alliance Church, Christ Church, or other places of worship). Or spend time on your own. A list of “Places to Go and Things to Do” will be provided.

Afternoon: We drive to the **Israel Museum** to see the **Dead Sea Scrolls** in the **Shrine of the Book**, as well as an outdoor **model of Jerusalem** as it may have looked in the Second Temple Period (1:50 scale). Tour the main archaeological section of the Museum. Return to the Ambassador Hotel for a **traditional Middle Eastern dinner and Special Guests!**




Day 13 Mon., June 13

JERUSALEM

City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, Western Wall, Ophel Excavations, Garden Tomb

We visit the original Jerusalem, the **City of David**, and explore the ancient water system. Those who wish may wade through water in **Hezekiah's Tunnel** to reach the **Pool of Siloam** (John 9)—bring flashlights, clothes you can get wet, and footwear for walking half an hour in water—while others who prefer a drier experience may take the 3800-year-old **Canaanite Tunnel**. Meet at the **Pool of Siloam**. Then we visit the **Western Wall** (once known as the Wailing Wall), where Bar Mitzvah ceremonies will be in progress. We



follow this with the **Ophel Excavations** (2 Chron. 33:14): on the southern edge of Jerusalem's **Temple Mount**, and climb the Temple steps where Jesus and his disciples would have walked. After lunch, drive to the **Garden Tomb** for a private tour and communion. Then return to the hotel for a change


of clothes and dinner. In the early evening depart for the airport, returning to our earthly homes on **June 14**. **You will never forget your spiritual home—the WORD will go from black and white to LIVING COLOR!**

A Note from DTBL! Founder, Kay Ritzman Money:


THE CALL...

Tour Features and Conditions

Please read all Tour Features and Conditions carefully. Payment of tour deposit constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Air Transportation: Air transportation is restricted to the services of any IATA carrier, in economy class based on nonrefundable fare. Travelers are responsible to provide their names as they appear in their passport. Ticketing will be made 30-45 days prior to departure, after which there will be a charge for name corrections. Tour price includes current airline taxes and fuel surcharges, which are subject to change until ticketed. *Tour participants are responsible for any increase in airline taxes or fuel surcharges imposed by the airline.*

Seat Assignments: Raptim Humanitarian Travel notes specific seat assignments as requested by tour members and submits them to the airline. However, the airline makes the actual assignments; there is no guarantee that all requests will be honored. Any changes should be requested at check-in by the traveler. Please advise your travel consultant of any special seating needs due to health or mobility, or note under "Airline Seat Request" when registering.

Accommodations: Based on two or more persons sharing a room in accommodations listed in itinerary, or similar. Single rooms are subject to availability at an additional charge. *If a passenger cannot supply a roommate, the passenger is responsible for the additional charge.*

Meals: In-flight meals and snacks are served according to airline policy. Breakfast and dinner will be provided daily.

Transfers and Baggage: Group transfers between airports and hotels upon arrival and departure are included in the tour price, including handling of one medium-sized suitcase per person, not exceeding 62 dimensional inches (length plus width plus height) or weighing more than a maximum of 50 pounds. Due to limited luggage storage space on motor coaches, it is important that each person bring only ONE piece of checked baggage. In addition, a flight bag or overnight case may be taken, which must be handled by the passenger at all times. Baggage allowance is subject to change according to airline policy.

Sightseeing and Entrance Fees: Are included as indicated in itinerary, using private motor coach or other conveyance, with local guides where necessary.

Tips and Taxes: Service charges and taxes on accommodations and tips to guides, drivers, and hotel staff are included. Tips for lunches and personal services are not included.

Not Included: Lunches and lunch tips, beverages with dinners, passport fee, travel protection insurance, checked baggage fees, and expenses of a purely personal nature are not included. Transportation from your home to departure city and return is not included.

Deposit and Payment: Reservations can be secured with a deposit payment of \$500 per person by February 25, 2016. You will be invoiced for final payment, which is due April 1, 2016.

Raptim Humanitarian Travel Cancellation Conditions: The cancellation conditions outlined below apply to all passenger initiated cancellations. Should circumstances require that the passenger cancel, written notice of cancellation must be received by Raptim Humanitarian Travel a minimum of 100 days prior to departure to secure any refund of deposit funds.

- From date of deposit to and including February 22, 2016: \$100 per person service fee applies (Exception: When tour is cancelled by the tour host within this time period, a \$35 per person service fee will apply.)
- From February 23 to and including April 1, 2016: Full deposit (\$500 per person) plus any unrecoverable fees apply
- After April 1, 2015: No refund

Cancellation policies apply when cancellation occurs for any reason. There is no refund for any unused services or portion of the tour package.

Non-U.S. citizens are responsible to fulfill entry requirements for countries to be visited by contacting the appropriate consulates. No inoculations are required, but please check with your physician for his recommendation.

Rates & Fares Information: Rates are based on a minimum of 18 persons traveling together. Fewer tour participants will result in a price increase. The quoted tour price is based on the current rate of exchange. Fluctuation in the foreign exchange rate can result in price increase.

Deviations: Any individual making a change in travel arrangements apart from this group program will be charged a service fee of \$100 per person, plus any additional air or land costs incurred. If you choose to make your own travel arrangements (not through Raptim Humanitarian Travel), we are not responsible for any charges or cancellation fees you may incur at any time.

Tour Operator Itinerary Changes: The itinerary as outlined is an indication of sequence and sites to be included in the tour program.
